AVAILABLE IMMUNIZATION CLINICS THRU LAFAYETTE COUNTY HEALTH DEPT

The Lafayette County Health Department is reminding parents to get an early start with required shots for school. There are many required Kindergarten booster immunizations and beginning this fall (fall of 2008-09) there are extra vaccines required in addition to the standard vaccine schedule. Additional vaccines include varicella (chicken pox), pneumococcal conjugate and Tdap (for Diptheria, Tetanus and Pertussis). The appropriate new required vaccines are dependant upon the age of your child.
